Stimulated to address these issues, the author continued his research by integrating it into current developments in the field. This resulted in a surprisingly successful series of events. Several publications in peer-reviewed scientific journals, and internationally in several magazines, described new concepts which were widely acclaimed, and this led to an invitation to be keynote speaker at a major conference and also to a job offer. The author wonders if there could have been a connection between the way he was treated as a relatively open gay man and the corporate cultures at Xerox and DuPont several decades ago. This book results from these reflections, which are expanded to include broader considerations such as the interpretation of the extreme homophobia in England half a century ago in terms of its unique...
