Commission on National Security 21 Century Today the United States produces about 106,000 education majors with a bachelors 13 degree. Excluding science and math, this raw number should be sufficient to serve most of the nations needs, but many choose not to go into education. The National Education Association points out that 30 percent of graduates never enter teaching, and of those who do, 30 percent leave within 14 the first five years. In major cities the problem is much worse; 50 percent leave within the first five years. Of greater concern is the loss of high quality graduates. Novice teachers scoring in the top 15 quartile on college-entrance examinations are nearly twice as likely to leave the profession. Continuation rates and new entrant rates - especially of science and math teachers - must to be improved through effective salary and scholarship incentives. These incentives are explained in later sections of this report....
