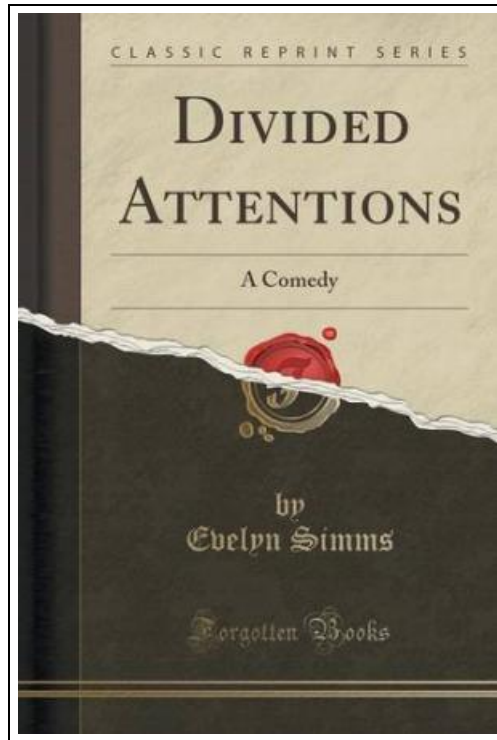


Divided Attentions: A Comedy (Classic Reprint)
